<u>John 11:6</u> - When Jesus heard that Lazarus was sick, He stayed <u>two more days</u> in the place where He was.

<u>John 11:38-40</u> - Jesus came to the tomb... and said, "Take away the stone... Didn't I say to you that if you'd believe you would see *the glory of God*?"

<u>John 9:3</u> - Jesus answered, "This happened so that <u>the works of God would be displayed in him.</u>

#### Red Sea Rule #4 - Pray!

- <u>v.10</u> When Pharaoh drew near, the children of Israel lifted their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians marched after them. So they were very afraid, and the children of Israel *cried out to the Lord*.
- <u>Job 8:5-6</u> But if you'll seek God <u>earnestly</u> and <u>plead</u> with the Almighty... surely He'd awake for you.
- <u>Mark 5:22-23</u> A synagogue leader named Jairus arrived, and seeing Jesus, he fell at His feet and <u>pleaded</u> with Him <u>urgently</u>, "My little daughter is near death. Please come and place Your hands on her, so that she'll be healed and live."
- <u>Luke 7:4</u> So they <u>earnestly begged</u> Jesus to help the man.
- <u>Luke 22:44</u> And being in anguish, Jesus prayed more <u>earnestly</u>.
- <u>James 5:17</u> Elijah... prayed <u>earnestly</u> that it wouldn't rain, and it didn't rain on the land for three and a half years.
- Col. 4:2 Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving.

<u>Deuteronomy 1:29-31</u> - Don't be terrified The LORD your God, who goes before you, He will fight for you.
<u>Deuteronomy 3:22</u> - You must not fear them, for the LORD your God Himself fights for you.
Romans 8:31-37 - If God is <i>for us</i> , who can be against us? What shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble, or hardship, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? In all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.
