2. They Denied God's Protection.

<u>James 1:2-4, 12</u> - Count it all joy, my brothers, when you encounter trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be <u>mature and complete</u>, not lacking anything... Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

3. They Doubted God's Presence.

Psalm 106:9-14 - [The Lord] rebuked the Red Sea, and it dried up; He led them through the depths as through a desert. ¹⁰ He saved them from the hand of the foe; from the hand of the enemy He redeemed them. ¹¹ The waters covered their adversaries, not one of them survived. ¹² Then they believed His promises and sang His praise. ¹³ But they soon *forgot* what He'd done and didn't wait for His plan to unfold. ¹⁴ In the desert they gave in to their craving; in the wilderness they put God to the test.

#2 - You Need A Staff You Can Raise

v. 8 - Now Amalek came and fought with Israel in Rephidim.

Ephesians 6:12 - Our struggle isn't against flesh and blood, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

<u>Deut. 25:17-18</u> - Remember what the Amalekites did to you along your way from Egypt, how they met you on your journey when you were *tired and weary*, and they attacked all who *lagged behind*;

<u>v. 9-13</u> - Moses said to Joshua, "Choose us some men and go out, fight with Amalek. Tomorrow I'll stand on the top of the hill with the staff of God in my hand." ¹⁰ So Joshua did as Moses said to him, and fought with Amalek. And Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill. ¹¹ And so it was, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed; and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed. ¹² But Moses' hands became heavy; so they took a stone and put it under him, and he sat on it. And Aaron and Hur supported his hands, one on one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun. ¹³ So Joshua defeated Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.
