<u>James 5:12</u> - But above all, <u>my brethren</u>, don't swear, either by heaven or by earth or with any other oath. But let your "Yes" be "Yes," and your "No," "No," lest you fall into judgment.

1. The Purpose of Vows

Psalm 76:11 - Make vows to the LORD your God and fulfill them.

Ps. 61:8 - I will sing praises to Your name forever as I fulfill my vows day after day.

<u>Hebrews 6:13</u> - When God made His promise to Abraham, since there was no one greater for Him to swear by, He swore by Himself.

2. The Problem with Vows

#1 - Rash vows

1 Sam. 14:24 - Saul bound the people under an oath, saying, "Cursed be anyone who eats food before evening comes."

#2 - Unkept vows

Mt. 23:16, 18 - "Woe to you, blind guides, who say, 'If anyone swears by the temple, <u>it's nothing</u>, but if anyone swears by the gold of the temple, <u>he is bound by his oath</u>.' And you say, 'If anyone swears by the altar, <u>it's nothing</u>, but if anyone swears by the gift that is on the altar, <u>he is bound by his oath</u>."

3. The Priority of Truth

James: Let your "Yes" be "Yes," and your "No," "No."

Genesis 12:18-19 - So Pharaoh summoned Abram and asked, "What have you done to me? Why didn't you tell me she was your wife? Why did you say, 'She is my sister,' so that I took her as my wife? Here is your wife. Take her and go!"

<u>Genesis 27:41</u> - Esau held a grudge against Jacob because of the blessing his father had given him. He said to himself, "The days of mourning for my father are near; then I will kill my brother Jacob."

Genesis 37:31-32 - Then the brothers killed a young goat and dipped Joseph's robe in its blood. They sent the robe of many colors to their father and said, "We found this. Examine it to see whether it is your son's robe or not."

<u>Luke 12:2-3</u> - "There is nothing concealed that won't be disclosed, or hidden that won't be made known. What you have said in the dark shall be heard in the light."

<u>Ps. 15:4</u> - The faithful followers of the LORD keep their promises even when it hurts.
