

# Awana Clubs

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- $\Rightarrow$  Awana Clubs start *promptly* at <u>6:50pm</u> and end *promptly* at <u>8:25pm</u> ... <u>Please be on time</u>. (notes)
  - <u>NOTE: Drop-off & Pick-up</u>: We will have a <u>special procedure</u> during the pandemic (see below).
- $\Rightarrow$  Please DO NOT SEND your child to Club if they have experienced any off the following:
  - Coughing or shortness of breath Elevated temperature or cold or flu symptoms Exposure to anyone with a cold or flu symptoms.

#### Drop-off:

- Parking lot will have a special 'traffic flow' with safety procedures:
  - > Parents/guardians will not enter the building.
  - > LHBC volunteers will check your child's temperature in your car (in the car line).
  - > All Awana leaders and directors will have their temperature checked before entering the building.
  - MASKS must be worn by <u>everyone</u> while inside the building as well.
- <u>Please note</u>: We ask that you plan for 'extra' time for check-in procedures.

### Pick-up:

- Parking lot will have a special 'traffic flow' with safety procedures:
  - > Parents / guardians will not enter the building. Designated entrance locations will have pick-up.
  - MASKS must be worn by *everyone* during pick-up. Your password will be asked upon pick-up.
- **<u>NOTE</u>**: At <u>8:25pm</u> Clubs will have their kids ready for pickup, at their designated locations.
- **<u>Please note</u>**: We ask that you plan for 'extra' time for pick-up procedures.
  - From the designated door, we will bring your child to your car in the car line.
- <u>*Please Note:*</u> We will be locking the "Link" doors from 7:15 8:15 for the safety of our children.

## Club procedures:

- 1. <u>REGISTRATION</u>: We ask parents to pay a one-time registration fee of \$25 per child **which includes their handbook for the year.** We do not collect nightly dues. <u>Registration includes</u>: your child's handbook, club-night dues, in-class activities during the year, and helps defray the cost of awards and club operation. If there is a financial hardship please contact the Awana office.
- 2. <u>CLUB ITEMS</u>: Clubbers will need to have the following items to fully participate in the club each week:
  - Bible, Handbook, sneakers, and Uniform for achievement patches, awards etc.
  - Awana Uniforms, book-bags, and other items are sold in the Awana Office: upstairs in the Family Life Center.
- 3. <u>AWANA OFFICE</u>: Office hours are on a 'request-basis' only. Please schedule a time for any needs from the office. You may contact your Club Director or Commander to schedule this.
- 4. <u>OTHER</u>:
  - If you need to speak to your child's club Director or club leader, please make arrangements *before* or *after club time* so that your child's leader can give full attention to the children in their club.
  - Bible memory verses and work sections in the handbooks may <u>only</u> be signed or passed by the clubber's leader, Director, or the Commander.
